



Bloom's Hierarchy

Many schools are finding Bloom's hierarchy an incredibly useful tool for further developing pupils' thinking skills and engagement of higher order skills such as evaluating and analysing. Applying these different levels of learning to classroom practice helps teachers with planning, differentiation, and stretching pupils beyond just understanding and remembering information.

This course will offer teachers opportunities to gain a deeper understanding of these different levels of learning and explore many novel ways in which they can be applied in the classroom.

This training can be adapted and modified to suit the individual needs of the school/organisation. It could be delivered as either a one day, half day or series of twilight taster sessions but is most effective as a one day course (or over 2 half day sessions).
