



Study Skills- Teaching pupils how to revise, make effective revision notes and improve their recall skills

Few pupils are explicitly taught how to study yet all are expected to do so independently at some stage in their formal education. This course can be adapted for teachers to guide pupils or for pupils themselves to learn these skills directly and have opportunities to try them out, share ideas with others and find what strategies and tools suit their own personal learning styles and preferences. Some of the tools featured include mind maps, multi-sensory learning, learning through colour and visualisation, making effective summary notes and how to use these notes for success .

This training can be adapted and modified to suit the individual needs of the school/organisation. It could be delivered as either a one day, half day or series of twilight taster sessions but is most effective as a one day course (or over 2 half day sessions).
