



Making Maths Marvellous

This workshop debunks the myths about maths being a very difficult subject that only certain people are good at. It breaks down key maths concepts into sets of transferable cognitive skills such as comparison, sequence, analogy and planning. By identifying these skills as the same that are needed for other curriculum subjects – pupils can be lead to the conclusion that if they can do one subject well, they can do any other as well. In turn this builds confidence and self-esteem as a learner.

This workshop works well for primary schools but can be adapted and be relevant for secondary SEN pupils.
