



Unlocking learning potential with visual graphic organisers

This workshop will explore making learning visual and more accessible to a range of learning styles. Using Hyerle's Thinking Maps in combination with diagrams, tables, matrices, Venn diagrams, decision trees etc. the workshop will consider how to encourage pupils to create their own visual organisation schemes. It will look at how visuals can aid the transfer and generalisation of understanding and skills and develop metacognition for active learning.

This workshop works well for primary schools but can be adapted and be relevant for secondary SEN pupils.
